Para 3


For:-

The last pay (i.e. pay in pay band + Grade Pay) drawn by the Officer/employee shall be applicable for the purpose of fixing the ceiling limit of reimbursement through self-certification. In the case of subsequent revision in pay scale, the corresponding pay in revised pay scale as fixed by NHAI (HQ) shall be applicable.

Read:-

The last pay (i.e. pay in pay band + Grade Pay) drawn by the Officer/employee shall be applicable for the purpose of fixing the ceiling limit of reimbursement through self-certification. In the case of subsequent revision in pay scale, the corresponding pay in revised pay scale as fixed notionally by NHAI (HQ) shall also be applicable to the retired employees.

3. Rest no change.

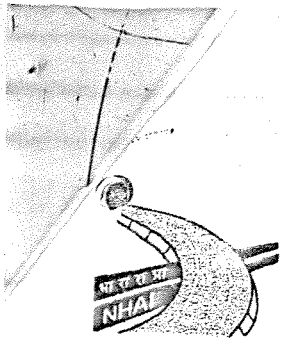

POLICY CIRCULAR

Sub: Post retirement medical facility (Out door treatment) for NHAI employees.

1. It has been decided to extend the post retirement medical benefits to the NHAI employees vide National Highways Authority of India (Medical Attendance and Treatment) Amendment Regulation 2006 published in Gazette Notification on 10th August, 2006. The outdoor treatment as applicable to the serving officials will also be available to the retired NHAI Officer/employees. This facility is made applicable with effect from 10.8.2006 i.e. the date of publication of gazette notification.

2. In order to avail the post retirement medical facility(including indoor treatment), a lump sum amount as indicated below is required to be paid as ten years contribution as payable by an employee of same pay scale for availing CGHS benefits in Central Government (in line with National Highways Authority of India (Medical Attendance and Treatment) Amendment Regulation, 2006:-

Grade Pay drawn by the Officer	Contribution (Rs.)
Upto Rs.1,650/- per month	6,000/-
Rs.1,800/-, Rs.1,900/-, Rs.2,000/-, Rs.2,400/- and Rs.2,800/- per month	15,000/-
Rs.4200/- per month	27,000/-
Rs. 4,600/-, Rs.4,800/-, Rs.5,400/- and Rs.6,600/- per month	39,000/-
Rs. 7,600/- and above per month	60,000/-

3. The last pay (i.e. Pay in Pay band+ Grade Pay) drawn by the officer / employee shall be applicable for the purpose of fixing the ceiling limit of reimbursement through self-certification. In the case of subsequent revision in pay scale, the corresponding pay in revised pay scale as fixed by NHAI (HQ) shall be applicable.



4. On retirement, the employee will exercise his option to draw the medical reimbursement quarterly from the concerned Regional Office/Headquarter Office and after depositing the prescribed contributions as mentioned in para 2 above, Administration Division will issue a letter to Headquarter/Regional Office confirming last pay drawn and amount of contributions deposited for reimbursement of medical claims.

5. The reimbursement claims on self certification basis in the prescribed format, may be submitted by the retired employee at the end of each quarter to the extent of one fourth of the last pay drawn, for each quarter, to the Finance Division of HQ or any RO as per the option of the employees. Option for submission of reimbursement claim to HQ/ RO once exercised can not be changed without the approval of competent authority.

6. Reimbursement of medical expenditure within the ceiling limit of one month's last pay drawn would be admitted on the basis of self-certificate given by the retired employee in the prescribed format on quarterly basis, to the effect that the expenditure has actually been incurred towards the treatment of self or any dependent member of his/her family.

7. In the cases where the claim of medical reimbursement for the whole year is more than the amount equivalent to last pay drawn, the retired employee will be required to submit his/her entire claim at the end of the year with all supporting cash memos/prescriptions to the Administration Division at NHAI (Hq) to process his/her claim for relaxation on a case to case basis.
