Sub: Public Notice Before Commencement of Fee Collection

Notifications for levy and collection of fee are published in the Official Gazette. Immediately on receipt of the published notification, the same is forwarded to the concerned PIU / CMU for their immediate necessary action for commencement of fee collection. It has been decided to give wide publicity to the levy of fee. Accordingly, the text of the notification should be published as a public notice in widely circulated newspapers in the area concerned one in Hindi, one in English and one in local language. A specimen of such public notice based on a recent Gazette Notification no.712 (E) dated 19th June, 2003 is enclosed. This action should be taken immediately on the receipt of the fee notification with a view to ensuring that it appears in the newspapers within the next two days. The public notice must also state the proposed date and time of start of the fee collection. Besides, (a) suitable press releases about it, as distinct from a public notice should be released at our cost in different newspapers, by the Project Director prior to the commencement of fee collection for wide publicity from time to time and (b) the concerned PDs shall ensure to keep the concerned District/State Authorities etc. informed of the proposed date of fee collection.

Whereas, the Central Government, vide notifications of the Government of India in the erstwhile Ministry of Surface Transport (Roads Wing), number 78 (E), dated 4th February issued under Section 11 of National Highways Authority of India Act 1988 (68 of 1988), entrusted the stretch from Km. 198.00 to Km. 263.00 (Bharuch-Surat Section) of National Highway No. 8 in the State of Gujarat to the National Highways Authority of India.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 7 of the National Highways Act, 1956 (48 of 1956), read with the rules 3,5, and 11 of the National Highways (Fees for the use of National Highway Section And Permanent Bridge-Public Funded Project) Rules, 1997, the Central Government hereby notifies that there shall be levied and collected by the National Highways Authority departmentally, directly or through private contractor on the basis of competitive bidding, a fee on mechanical vehicles for the use of the said stretch from Km. 198.00 to Km. 263.00 (Bharuch-Surat Section) of National Highway No. 8 in the State of Gujarat at the rates specified in the Schedule annexed hereto.

Following rate of fee to be recovered from the users. The fee shall be collected at single location only within the stretch proposed.

1. when the same vehicle has to cross the toll gate more than once in a day, the user shall have the option to pay one and half times the above rates while crossing the gate in the first trip itself or if the vehicle has to use the said stretch continuously and frequently for entire month, the vehicle owner can have a monthly pass on payment of charges equal to thirty times single rates applicable to it as specified in the aforesaid Schedule.

2. The following types of vehicles are exempted from the fee specified above in the Schedule, namely:-

(i) Defence Vehicle (ii) Police Vehicle (iii) Vehicles having Very Important Person symbols' (iv) Fire Fighting Vehicles (v) Ambulances (vi) Funeral Vans (vii) Post and Telegraph Department Vehicles (viii) Central Government and State Government vehicles on duty.

3. The vehicle belongs to any one of the followings shall be deemed to be vehicles having Very Important Person symbols, namely:-

i) President of India (ii) Vice President of India (iii) Central and State Ministers, while in vehicles (iv) Leaders of Opposition in Lok Sabha or Rajya Sabha or State Legislatures having the status of cabinet Ministers, while in Vehicles (v) Governors of States (vi) Lieutenant Governors of Union Territories (vii) Speakers or Chairman of Central and State Legislatures, while in Vehicles (viii) Members of Parliament in the entire country on production of Identity Card issued by Parliament (ix) Members of Legislative Assemblies or Legislative Councils within the State on production of Identity Card issued by the respective Legislature (x) Foreign dignitaries on State Visit to India (xi) Foreign Diplomats stationed in India using cars with CD or CC number Plate (xii) Winners of the gallantry awards namely Param Vir Chakra, Ashok Chakra, Maha Vir Chakra, Kirti Chakra, Vir Chakra and Shaurya Chakra on production of Identity Card authenticating the award by the Competent Authority.

4. the rates of fee, the categories of vehicles exempted from payment of fee and the name, address and telephone number of the authority to whom complaints, if any, should be addressed, shall be conspicuously and prominently displayed 500 metres ahead of the toll booths, 100 metres ahead of the toll booths and the toll booths also, the height of the display boards and size of letters being such that it is easy for drivers to read the display boards.
