CIRCULAR NO. NHAI/Commercial Operations/15

SUB: EXEMPTION OF COMPLETED SECTIONS FROM LEVY OF FEE

As per present policy, all completed 4/6/8 lane National Highways are subjected to levy of fee under the National Highways Act, 1956. However, for small completed sections of National Highways or length of completed sections falling within the city limits, it may not be feasible to levy the fee. This requires National Highways Authority of India to obtain specific exemption from the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, Govt. of India.

It has been decided that

- i) *All PIUs shall submit requisite information in the enclosed format to Concerned Technical Division at HQ in respect of **such sections to be exempted** as per following time frame:-*
 - (a) *In respect of such sections already completed as on 31.3.2003, information is required to be submitted one time only by 30th April 2003.*
 - (b) *In respect of sections likely to be completed during April-Sept 2003, information must also be sent by 30th of this month to the concerned Technical Division.*
 - (c) *Concerned Technical Division at HQ at the level of CGM shall ensure to provide consolidated information for all the packages to CM Division by 30th April 2003 for onward submission to the Ministry for their approval.*
 - (d) *Thereafter, the schedule will be as follows:*



- ii) *Corridor Management Division shall forward the cases for seeking exemption from the Ministry for entire NHDP.*
- iii) *Any clarification required subsequently by the Ministry will be provided by the concerned GM(Tech).*
