### POLICY MATTER : TECHNICAL (61/2010)

(Decision taken in file No. NHAI/CM/Wayside Amenities/2005 of CM Division)

**Sub: Provision of Wayside Amenities in new projects of improvement of highways on BOT (Toll)/BOT (Annuity)/EPC basis**

National Highways Authority of India proposes to establish wayside amenities at every around 50 kms (alternatively) along National Highways. The Wayside Amenities would broadly, but not limited to, include Truck Lay byes, A.C.Restaurant / Snack Bar, Low cost Dhabha, Toilets, Telephone Booth / ATM, Rest Rooms for short stay, dormitories, retail outlets, minor repair shops, Shops for sale of Misc./sundry items and space for spreading Government welfare programme etc.

2. It has been observed that after the development of highways (either 4/6 lane) which are completed, no surplus land is generally available for development of wayside amenities and around 2-5 Ha land is required for development of comprehensive wayside amenities.
3. It has now been decided that while preparing the DPR/Feasibility study reports for new projects of 4/6 laning, the DPR/Feasibility consultant may be directed to identify the potential sites for development of wayside amenities along with the other project facilities. The potential sites may also be located near the places of tourist importance such as scenic points, rivers or waterfalls, popular religious places, toll and octroi barriers. Accordingly, the land measuring about 2 to 5 hectares may be acquired along with the other land acquisition required for the project stretch.
4. All CGMs / ROs must ensure that field staff have personally inspected prospective sites. Regional CGMs must assess the sites from the point of view of road user's convenience.
5. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.
