NHAI/Policy Guidelines/Consultation/2019/No. 2.1.32/2020 dated 21.01.2020

It has been brought to my notice by CCIEs that in many cases before the Arbitral Tribunals (ATs), even though NHAI had a strong legal basis to defend the claims, the full facts of the case were not brought out before the ATs, which have weakened the defence of NHAI. It may lead to varying amount of losses to NHAI in different cases.

2. Therefore, henceforth, a team comprising of PD, CGM/RO, GM(T) of Tech Division at HQ & GM(Legal) shall review the Statement of Defence/ Counter-claims of NHAI in all ongoing arbitrations/ future arbitrations and certify to this effect. GM(Legal) may provide at least one (preferably two) YP(Legal) exclusively for each Tech Division at HQ to assist the above team. In case it is found at a later date that full facts of the case were not brought out in the above statements, action will be taken against the concerned team of officers for the laxity/connivance causing financial loss to NHAI.
