
**Policy Matters: Technical (157/2014)**  
(Decision taken on File No.NHAI/DRQA/Misc/2010)

**Sub.: Procedure for Challenging the Arbitral Award passed by majority of Arbitrators and also containing Dissenting Note of one Arbitrator.**

The procedure for referring the matter for Arbitration/ filing petition or appeal in Court of Law was issued vide Policy Circular No. Tech./133/2013 dated 08.05.2013. As per this Circular, as soon as the decision of DRB or the Arbitral Tribunal or the Court is received, the same has to be placed before the concerned Member, who will immediately form a Committee of 3 GMs to process the matter and submit recommendations for arriving at final decision either by the concerned Member or the Executive Committee.

2. After scrutiny of several cases of such nature, the Competent Authority has decided that the Arbitral Award passed by majority of the Arbitrators which has a dissenting note of one of the Arbitrators, the recommendations of 3 GMs Committee need not be referred to the Executive Committee for taking decision on challenging of the Arbitral Award. Such Arbitral Awards can be challenged with the approval of the concerned Member. If, however, the Member feels that the award should be accepted, the matter may be placed before the Executive Committee well within the period of limitation.
