Subject : Guidelines for formulation, Appraisal and Approval of Government Plan funded Projects/ Schemes related to Ministry of Road Transport and Highways.

This is in continuation of OM No 1(3)/PF.II/2001 dated 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2007 and in partial modification of OM No. F No 1(3)/PF.II/2001 dated 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2010 conveying Guidelines for formulation, Appraisal and Approval of Government Plan funded Projects/ Schemes. In order to address the need for simplification and clarity in the overall procedure, the delegation of powers in respect of Ministry of Road Transport and Highways has been revised as follows.

2. FOR ORIGINAL COST ESTIMATES

Appraisal and Approval of Public Funded (Non PPP) Plan schemes/projects as per the revised delegation are as per table shown below:
