POLICY MATTERS-ADMINISTRATION/FINANCE (76/2012)
(Decision taken on File No. NHAI/EW-III/WB-4/2005/Tech(Pt.))

Subject: Authorization to issue Project Authority Certificate to signing of Deemed Export Certificate for "Excise Duty Exemption Certificate" to be issued by NHAI in favour of the Contractor.

In respect of Externally Aided Projects (EAPs) like World Bank, Asian Development Bank etc., exemption from payment of excise duty is admissible under Notification No.108/95-CE dated 28.5.1995. In addition, the Department of Economic Affairs, Ministry of Finance, vide Public notice number 1(FT)/DEA/2000 dated 9.8.2000 has notified some agencies for the purpose of grant of deemed export benefits. Accordingly, the Contractors either avail the excise duty exemption under notification No.108/95-CE or avail duty drawback under the deemed export benefits.

2. Policy Matter Administration/Finance No.13/2007 dated 12.7.2007 read with Office Order dated 9th September, 2009 on duties/responsibility of Regional Officer (RO) was leading to a state of conflict whether Regional Officer is recommending authority for issuing of certificate or is final authority to issue certificate as the Regional Officers are the CGM handling the project.

3. The matter was brought before the Competent Authority and it has now been decided that Duty Export Benefit Certificates are to be issued by the Concerned Regional Officer (CGM).
