### **POLICY MATTERS : TECHNICAL (51/2005)**

(Decision taken on File No. NHA/06/E.M./2004)

#### **Sub: Entrustment of Stretches.**

- Ref: 1) Circular No. 11041/21/2002-Admn dated 3<sup>rd</sup> Feb 2004.  
2) Ministry letter No. NH-14012/4/2005-P&M dated 23.03.2005.

National Highways Authority of India is mandated to implement National Highways Development Project (NHDP). The scope of NHDP is being extended to improve more National Highways to 4/6-lane configuration. For implementation of NHDP by NHA, entrustment of stretches covered under it to National Highways Authority of India by the Central Government is imperative. Timely entrustment of stretches to National Highways Authority of India by the Central Government is also essential to avoid any legal complications. It has therefore, been desired by the Competent Authority that following procedures may be adopted for proposals related to entrustment of stretches:-

- i) Technical Divisions will identify the stretches for which notification entrusting the stretch to NHA has not been published among the projects being implemented at present under NHDP as well as fresh stretches covered under extended NHDP to be entrusted to NHA by the Central Government.
- ii) Concerned Technical Division will process the draft of the notification for entrustment of the above-mentioned stretches and send the same to EM Division.
- iii) EM Division will be responsible for scrutinizing the proposal and processing the same through DoRT&H to the Ministry of Law for vetting and subsequent publication in the Official Gazette of India Extraordinary. GM (EM) will be nodal officer for liaising with the Deptt. of Road Transport, MoSRT&H and the Legislative Deptt., M/o of Law for issue of such notifications.
- iv) After publication of the notification, the Concerned Technical Division will send a copy of it to EM Division of NHA which in turn would forward 100 copies of the same to P&M Wing of the Ministry to enable it to lay it in Parliament.

v) One copy each of notifications of the stretches other than those mentioned above, which are available in Library and the Corridor Management Division, may also be sent to GM(EM).

vi) EM Division will also ensure that notification number and date of entrustment are compiled and placed in a data base to be created by IT division. In case any notification for entrustment is pending in the Ministry, which has been referred to the Ministry by National Highways Authority of India, copies of references to the Ministry may also be sent to GM (EM) for further necessary follow up action.



#### **Sub: Entrustment of Stretches**

It has come to notice that certain sections of National Highways or part thereof have not been entrusted to NHAI by the MoRT&H where NHAI is supposed to take up the work. Such entrustment is a pre-requisite before the start of civil construction work for that section. It has therefore been desired by the Competent Authority that all Technical sections in NHAI must carefully examine the notifications of the stretches entrusted to NHAI in their jurisdiction and pass on a copy of these notifications to General Manager(Estate Management) for his record and reference. One copy of notification, which are available in Library may also be passed on to GM(EM). The concerned Technical Division shall put up draft notification to the GM(EM) for entrustment of the stretches which have not been entrusted to NHAI so far and GM(EM) will be the nodal authority for liaising with the Ministry for issue of such notification and he will ensure that all notifications are issued well in time.

2. The GM(EM) will also ensure that notification number & date of entrustment are compiled and placed in the permanent record of IT division. In case any entrustment notification is pending in the Ministry which has been referred to the Ministry by NHAI, copies of references to the Ministry may also be sent to GM(EM) for follow up action.

Please refer to the following notifications of entrustment of NH stretches to the executive agencies got issued by NHA on their File No.NHA/11015/7/2001/Tech/GM(WB)-I:

- (i) Notification No.S.O. 1267(E), dated 16<sup>th</sup> Nov., 2004 regarding entrustment of NH 45B to NHA.
- (ii) Notification No.S.O. 1268(E), dated 16<sup>th</sup> Nov., 2004 regarding entrustment of NH 45 (Chennai - Trichy Section) to the NHA.
- (iii) Notification No. S.O. 1269(E), dated 16<sup>th</sup> Nov., 2004 regarding entrustment of NH to the State Government of Tamil Nadu.

2. Roads Wing in Ministry is responsible for processing all proposals relating to entrustment of National Highways. Proposals for above notifications were not received in Roads Wing. Presumably, notifications were issued through a single file system. In the notification at Sl.No.(iii) above NH-45B in Tamil Nadu has been entrusted to the National Highways Authority of India. Since the existence of the notifications No.S.O. 1267(E), dated 16<sup>th</sup> Nov., 2004 was not known to the Ministry, in the notifications issued by us dated 20.12.2004, NH- 45B is still being shown as entrusted to State Government of Tamil Nadu.

3. The Sections of NH 45 entrusted to NHA vide notification No.S.O. 1268(E) dated 16.11.2004 are already entrusted to NHA vide notification No. S.O. 78(E), dated 4.2.1999.

4. These anomalies are due to a parallel processing by the NHA through a single file system. Also, the notifications dated 16<sup>th</sup> Nov., 2004 should have been laid on the table of either Houses of Parliament during the Winter Session. As the Ministry was not aware of the existence of the notifications, no action was to take to lay the notifications. At this stage, these papers can only be laid with a statement showing reason for delay.

5. Instructions have already been issued regarding the procedure to be adopted for processing entrustment and connected notifications vide this Ministry's letter No.NH-14012/23/2004-P&M, dated 2.8.2004. NHA should discontinue the single file system in so far as entrustment of National Highways and connected notifications are concerned. Such proposals may please be sent to the Ministry through the normal channel for secretarial scrutiny in the first instance, scrutiny by the Ministry of Law and thereafter publication in the Gazette.
