### Policy Circular: (7.1.50/2016)

**Sub: Amendment of NHA1 circular No. 11041/21/2002-Admn.III Dated 24.12.2002{Policy Matters: Administration/Finance (30/2002)} regarding provisions of support staff and contingencies to Arbitrators appointed under NH Act, 1956 -reg**

The following amendments are being made to the circular No. 11041/21/2002-Admn.III dated 24.12.2002{Policy Matters: Administration/Finance(30/2002)}:

2. It has, therefore, been decided with the approval of the Competent Authority that an amount of Rs. 10,000/- per month may be sanctioned to each of the Arbitrators initially for a period of 6 months, where the arbitration work has commenced.	RO shall be the authority competent to approve / sanction proposals for support staff and contingencies upto an amount of Rs.40,000/- per month to each of the Arbitrators, if the number of pending cases are from 50-150 and Rs.60,000/- per month, if the number of pending cases are more than 150. Proposals may be forwarded to the Competent Authority with details of disposal during the previous 12 months.


2. The aforesaid limit, as specified under column 2 of the table above, is the maximum ceiling limit. However, the sanction should be accorded on receipt of specific proposal from Arbitrators with full justification.

3. The amount sanctioned for facilities to the Arbitrators shall be deducted from the Administrative charges given to the States for LA activities.

4. All other conditions in the circular No.1 1041/21/2002-Admn.III Dated 24.12.2002 {Policy Matters: Administration /Finance(30/2002)}shall remain unchanged. The said circular is enclosed herewith.

5. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.

**Sub: Payment of compensation to Arbitrators appointed by MoRT&H as per provision laid down in NH Act, 1956 to settle the disputes arising out of determination of compensation already paid to the land losers**

The Arbitrators appointed by Ministry of Road Transport and Highways as per provision laid down in NH Act, 1956 to settle the disputes arising out of determination of compensation paid to the land losers, are facing difficulties in smooth functioning of the arbitration proceedings in the absence of provisions for support staff and contingencies.

2. It has, therefore, been decided with the approval of the Competent Authority that an amount of Rs.10,000/- per month may be sanctioned to each of the Arbitrators initially for a period of 6 months, where the arbitration work has commenced.

3. The amount may be met out of project contingencies.

4. The Arbitrator will open a separate bank account and the Arbitrator and Project Director of NHAI will operate this account jointly. The concerned Technical Division will ensure that proper accounts of the expenditure are maintained for the audit of these accounts in the same manner as followed for depositing the amount by the Central Government with the Competent Authority for acquisition of land.
