POLICY MATTERS-TECHNICAL (114/2012)

(Decision taken in 122nd Meeting of Executive Committee held on 5.10.2012)

Sub: Procedure for processing of cases of Utility Shifting.

In order to speed up the disposal off the estimates of utility shifting, it has been decided to adopt the following procedure:

- (i) PD shall obtain the estimates of utility shifting from the concerned user departments within 3 months from the signing of the Concession Agreement.
- (ii) After examining, PD shall submit the estimate of utility shifting within a period of 10 days to RO in case it is within the delegated powers of ROs.
- (iii) If it is not within the delegated power of RO, the PD will submit the estimate directly to the HQs with a copy to concerned RO for his recommendation.
- (iv) In case RO has no observation to make the recommendation shall be forwarded within 7 days otherwise within a period of 10 days if any inspection of site is to be made in case RO needs to inspect.
- (v) The proposal received from RO shall generally be dealt by GM or DGM level officers at HQ and shall be disposed off with a period of 15 days.


2. It is also observed that the present delegation of powers issued vide Policy Circular (Tech. No.109/2012) dated 18.7.2012 is not adequate. Accordingly, in supersession to Policy Circular (Tech. No.109/2012) dated 18.7.2012, it has been decided to delegate following powers for sanctioning of estimates of utility shifting to the Regional Officers:

Sl. No.	Particular	To whom delegated	Extent of Delegation (Cumulative)
(i)	Transmission line / electric line shifting	Regional Officer	Rs. 5 crores for each concerned Division of User Agency
(ii)	Water pipelines and other utilities other than electric lines	Regional Officer	Rs. 2 crores for each concerned division of User Agency

3. The estimates have to be dealt in entirety and should not be bifurcated.

4. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.
