Sub.: Guidelines on implementation of the National Policy on Resettlement and Rehabilitation (NPRR) –reg.

The Ministry of Rural Development (Department of Land Resources), Government of India has notified the National Policy on Resettlement and Rehabilitation (NPRR) for project affected families-2003; which was Published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary Part-I, Section 1, vide No- 46, dated 17th February, 2004.

Pursuant to notification of the NPRR; the Authority, in its 58th meeting held on 20.04.2006, has decided that henceforth in all NHDP project (except those projects where a specific R&R framework has been adopted) all "Titleholder Project Affected Families" will be paid an ex-gratia amount of Rs. 10,000/=.

For the purpose of this circular:

A "Project Affected Family" means a family/person whose place of residence or other properties or source of livelihood are substantially affected by the process of acquisition of land for the project and who has been residing continuously for a period of not less than three years preceding the date of notification of the intent to acquire land for the project or practicing any trade, occupation or vocation continuously for a period of not less than three years in the affected zone; preceding the date of notification of the intent to acquire land.

A "family" means a Project Affected Family consisting of such person, his or her spouse, minor sons, unmarried daughters, minor brothers or unmarried sisters, father, mother and other members residing with him and dependent on him for their livelihood.

The guidelines will be applicable in all projects where the process of land acquisition has just started, and the payment of compensation is still due.
