POLICY MATTERS-ADMN & FINANCE (83/2012)

Sub: Delegation of Power during intermediate stages in Pre-qualification of Bidders in procurement of PPP Projects.

As per the current practice, the approval of Chairman is solicited at every stage of Pre-qualification of Bidders before inviting RFP.

2. Considering that soliciting approval of Chairman at each stage consumes a lot of time, as along taking into account the increasing mandate of NHAI, it has been decided to streamline the procedure, so that the prequalification process is completed in least possible time. Accordingly, it has been decided to follow the following procedure for pre-qualification of bidders:

- (i) For invitation of RFQ for a project, approval of Chairman shall be obtained on file.
- (ii) The constitution of the Evaluation Committee shall be approved at Member level. Short-listing of pre-qualified bidders, based on recommendation of the Evaluation Committee, shall be approved at the level of Member.
- (iii) If there is a rejection/disqualification of any applicant or an issue of interpretation, the matter shall be placed in the immediate next Executive Committee Meeting for decision.

3. For all intermediate stages involved in RFQ bidders, the power for according approval are delegated to the concerned Members dealing with the project.
