POLICY MATTERS – TECHNICAL (25/2009)

(Decision taken on CM Division's Note No. NHA/CM/Misc-2009)

Sub: Problem related to the repair of road and using mechanical aids such as mechanized cutters and hot mix propelled in the bid document.

The agenda item for problem related to the repair of road and using mechanical aids such as mechanized cutters and hot mix propelled in the bid document along with the maintenance of the stretch under six laning (Phase V) were discussed in 42nd Executive Committee meeting held on 04.03.2009.

- (i) It is observed that where there is urgency of carrying out repair work of stretches passing through built up road for area especially for NH-34, NH-205 and NH-215, the use of mechanized cutters and hot mix propellers may be necessary. Hence, it has been decided that the concerned Technical division responsible for repair of roads may use the above machinery by making suitable provision in the bid document.
 - (ii) It has also been observed that sometime sufficient time is elapsed between invitation of RFP and mobilization of BOT concessionaire for six-laning under NHDP phase-V. As per the MCA, the road is to be maintained in same condition as it was seven days prior to the submission of RFP. The certain stretches some time needs extensive repair in the intervening period in case of damages due to flood or torrential rain. Hence, it has been decided that proper maintenance of such damaged stretches awarded under 6-laning (Phase V) may be carried out by using DBM, BC (as per site requirement) for keeping the road in traffic worthy condition during development period. Accordingly, in future provision for such anticipated situation may be kept in the estimates.
2. A strict compliance of the above instructions be ensured.
 3. This issue with the approval of Competent Authority.
