POLICY MATTERS: TECHNICAL (67/2006)

[Decision taken on EW Division's file No. NHAI/Tech/Raj/Award/2004]

Sub.: Evaluation of bid capacity for EPC Contracts (NHAI funded)-reg.

In accordance with the decision taken in one of the weekly meetings, the work awarded to a Concessionaire under PPP Scheme (BOT/BOT(Annuity)) is generally not being considered in determining bid capacity for NHAI projects. In order to have uniform guidelines, it may be noted that for all future projects, while determining whether a Contractor has adequate bid capacity, the works awarded to Contractor as Concessionaire under PPP Scheme should not be considered as work in hand. This is because under PPP Scheme, the Concessionaire can get these works executed through any EPC Contractor. Further, the funds are arranged through financial institutions before achieving Financial Close for that particular project. As such, the projects under PPP Scheme need not be considered as a liability (work in hand) while determining the bid capacity.

This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.
