### **POLICY MATTERS-ADMINISTRATION/FINANCE [123/2006]**

(Decision taken on Finance Division File No.NHA/F&A/Maint.-Roads/2005-06/D-4)

#### **Sub : Release of funds to State PWDs for maintenance of National Highways-reg.**

Kindly refer to Policy Circular No.81/2004 dated 13<sup>th</sup> April, 2004 regarding release of funds to the State PWDs for carrying out the maintenance on the stretches which have been entrusted to NHAI but where the civil construction is yet to start. The Competent Authority has approved that the norms for release of funds to the State PWDs for maintenance of National Highways for the Financial Year 2006-07 would be Rs.2 lac per km/yr. (Rs.0.50 lac per km/yr. for Ordinary Repairs (OR) and Rs.1.50 lac per km/yr. for Periodical Repairs (PR) including Special Repairs (SR)/ Flood Damage Repairs (FDR).

- 2) The norms shall be applicable for the stretches of NS&EW Corridors where civil works contracts have not been awarded; for the stretches of NHDP Phase-III which have been entrusted to NHAI and where BOT Contracts are yet to be awarded and it is essential to carryout maintenance of roads; and other national highways entrusted to NHAI where maintenance liability is of NHAI and where contracts for upgradation are yet to be awarded.
- 3) Tech. Divisions may ensure that the maintenance work are required to be carried out and satisfy themselves before sending any proposal to the Finance Division for approval of estimates.
- 4) Tech. Divisions may send the proposals for approval of estimates for the year 2006-07 based on the norms proposed in para-1 above through the Member concerned to Member (Fin.). Such proposals will be examined in the Finance Division and approval of Chairman shall be obtained.
- 5) All the other procedures prescribed in the Policy Circular No.81/2004 shall be applicable in so far the procedural aspects/release of payment is concerned which has been prescribed in para-2 to para-6 of the said Circular.
